



Curriculum Statement - French

The importance of studying French is to enable students to become more open-minded, develop their culture awareness and become tolerant of other nations.

The French lesson content will focus on different themes such as free time and leisure activities, holidays and work and education. On top of expanding their vocabulary, students will have to learn how to master various grammatical points.

Teaching will focus on all four skills, which are speaking, reading, listening and writing. Pupils will be participating in role-plays and conversation related to day-to-day situation.

Students are supported with their development in and outside the classroom, with the support of a foreign language assistant to practise their speaking. They also have the opportunity to take part in a school trip to immerse themselves in the French culture.

The skills the students will develop throughout these sessions are lifelong skills which will help with the wider world of work and adult relationships.
